Other Reports

President Streeter updated the board on the pursuit of grants related to COVID-19 issues. The OCRA grant being applied for will be used to supply working capitol to local businesses who employ low to middle income

residents. The grant application requires established guidelines for disbursing the money. The board agreed to provide tiered grants: up to \$5000 for businesses employing less than 25 people and up to \$10,000 for businesses employing over 25 people.

Attorney Drew Porter update the board on an FSSA contract to enroll Knox County inmates into Federal or State Medicare. FSSA needs a contact person for billing and quarterly reports. Mr. Porter expects a contract available by the next meeting.

Knox County received an award letter for the 2020 Community Crossing matching grant in the amount of \$603,562.50.

Attorney Drew Porter updated the board on the land lease contracts for the property known as the Knox County Poor Farm. Two leases (County Poor Farm Hospice House and Isiah 1:17) are being drafted and will be amended before presenting to interested parties for signature.

The next meeting of the Knox County Commissioners will be held on Wednesday May 6th, 2020 at 10:00 am.
