Trent Hinkle discussed the opportunity for grant monies from OCRA for comprehensive county planning. The grant is for up to \$50,000 with a 10% local match. SIDC would help the county with the grant application.

President Kellie Streeter updated the board on the disbursement of the OCRA COVID-19 small business grants. The first round of awards have been mailed, the second round of awards are being reviewed, the third round is now open and applications are on the Knox County website.

President Kellie Streeter updated the board on the local implementation of the CARES act grant. Costs are still being reviewed and processed.

Knox County Sheriff Doug Vantlin informed the board that the sheriff's department should have a new body scanner installed by the end of the week.
